

The goal of the NJASP is to provide encouragement and development opportunities to Bermudian junior athletes between the ages of **15** - **19**, who clearly show commitment, promise and achievement in their respective sport. For fiscal year 2023/24, the NJASP committee allocated **\$49,967.00** to 16 National Sport Governing Bodies (NSGB's) toward initiatives that will enhance our junior athletes. Allocations are as follows:

Bermuda Amateur Swimming Association have been allocated a sum of \$2,769 for Brandon Adkins (17) to attend a 4 week training camp at Baylor School with Coach Payton Brooks. Bermuda Basketball Association have been allocated a sum of \$3,029 for Ralph Scott (15) to attend 2 the Point Guard College Basketball Camp. Bermuda Bicycle Association have been allocated a sum of \$2,312 for Annabelle Miller (18) to race 3 at the Intelligentsia Cup in Chicago, which will prepare her to represent Bermuda at the Commonwealth Youth Games in Trinidad. Bermuda Cricket Board have been allocated a sum of \$3,749 for Luke Fulton (16) to attend the Steffan Jones Pace Lab. Bermuda Equestrian Federation have been allocated a sum of \$3,000 for Cody Rego (18) to continue to 5 compete on the East Coast and transport his horse to competitions. Bermuda Football Association have been allocated a sum of \$2,914 for Harry Twite (17) to attend the 6 Galacticos Soccer Camp in Liverpool. Bermuda Rugby Football Union have been allocated a sum of \$2,488 for Malachi Paynter (17) to attend the U19 Caribbean Championship. Bermuda Sailing Association have been allocated a sum of \$5,707 for Sebastian Kempe (18) to 8 compete at the ILCA 7 Men's World Championships in Adelaide, Australia. Bermuda Sanshou Association have been allocated a sum of \$3,751 for Kallan Todd (16) to compete at 9 the World Kickboxing and Karate Championships in Bali, Indonesia. Bermuda Volleyball Association have been allocated a sum of \$2,659 for Makaylie Smith (16) to attend 10 an overseas training camp in preparation to represent Bermuda. Bermuda Boxing Federation have been allocated a sum of \$3,374 to host a 7 day intensive training camp 11 featuring Coach Hilario Zapata. National Archery Association of Bermuda have been allocated a sum of \$2,968 to host the Geneva 12 Archery Camp, featuring Coach Phil Graves. Bermuda Hockey Federation have been allocated a sum of \$2,915 to host a training camp on island 13 featuring **Sportsways Coaches**. Bermuda Netball Association have been allocated a sum of \$2,541 to host a training camp on island 14 featuring Americas Federation of Netball coaches. Bermuda Triathlon Association have been allocated a sum of \$3,041 to host the Youth Development 15 Camp featuring Parker Spencer and local coaches.

Bermuda Motorcycle Racing Association have been allocated a sum of \$2,750 to host the 2B Motor-
